

# Blackhawks top Kansas, 47-20

**TOPEKA, KS** – The Iowa Blackhawks continued their early season success by defeating longtime rival Kansas Koyotes 47-20 in an early season rematch of 2009's American Professional Football League championship game.

Iowa's defense held the Koyotes offense to 134 yards of total offense (-3 yards rushing) including six sacks. Defensive linemen Derek Phillips and Lamin Rucker had two sacks each with Phillips scoring on a four yard blocked field-goal attempt in the first quarter. Defensive back Alsid Panteau led all Blackhawks defenders with 11 solo tackles.

Quarterback Chuck Wright completed 12 of 19 passes for 181 yards and four touchdowns. Wide receiver Steve Rush caught six passes for 72 yards and three touchdowns. Brad Triplett hauled in three passes for 69 yards and one score. Running back Mell Holliday added two late touchdown runs to cap off the scoring.
