

## Blackhawks still have say in playoff picture

The Iowa Blackhawks will host three-time defending American Professional Football League champion Kansas Koyotes Saturday at the Mid-America Center at 7:05 p.m.

Iowa (7-4) will look to rebound from a disappointing loss to the Wichita Aviators last Saturday, in a game that may determine where the Blackhawks will play their opening round playoff game. Kansas sits atop the APFL leader board at 10-1, with the Aviators right behind at 9-2.

A win by the Blackhawks will put the Koyotes in a must-win situation against the Aviators in the final week of the regular season on July 15. This game may also determine whom Iowa will face first in the opening round on July 22.

"We need to prove our worth this weekend," said Blackhawks owner Jake Hiffernan. "It's important to show (the league) that we are capable of winning the championship."

The Blackhawks will host "Cuffs and Ladders" night to salute the local law enforcement officers, firefighter, and EMT crews. Pre-game celebration will feature fire trucks and law enforcement vehicles on the field for player introductions and an educational look at those vehicles at the South Entrance before the game.
