### Blackhawks hold off Springfield

SPRINGFIELD, Mo. – Chuck Wright threw three touchdown passes and Iowa’s defense brought its game up a level in a 23-14 win over Springfield Saturday.

Led by Chris Moore’s two interceptions, the Blackhawks (2-1) allowed the Wolf Pack to score only one offensive touchdown while picking up their second consecutive win.

Iowa head coach Mike Wolff took over the defensive play calls for his team this week and said his players on that side of the ball responded well to the changes.

“It was a hard-fought, hard-hitting game,” he said. “We still made a lot of mistakes. But anytime you get a road win in this league, it’s a good thing.”

The Blackhawks led 9-8 after a low-scoring first half. Springfield returned a kickoff for a touchdown following an Iowa score in the third period to keep the game close.

Wright’s TD pass to Andrew Seymour in the final period put the game out of reach. Robert Kirvin and Steve Rush also had touchdown catches for Iowa, which is off until its April 29 home game against Sioux City.
